Administrator/Clerk's Report

Discussed the Courier Contract with CLI and after discussion the board agreed to remove the section from the contract granting the use of the county vehicle for private courier services.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mike Adelman stated that he has been seeking a person to fill the position on The Shelter Board,

(Domestic Violence Shelter) and has a couple of possibilities.

The board agreed that the cell phone policy that was presented to them by the Administrator/Clerk that she received from Erie County should be given to Daivia Kasper, Assistant Prosecutor for her review. The Board felt that it is a good policy.

Mr. Adelman also discussed the Board of Elections' minutes in regards to the budget, along with the proclamations and the school board's reception.

Gary Bauer discussed a problem ditch that the board received a letter in concern of, and stated that he had discussed this situation with Cary Brickner Soil &Water Conservation District. Mr. Brickner explained that this group of land owners was informed that they must come of with \$2,000 for the good faith money, and after this was accomplished it is currently on the desk of the state engineer. It is moving through the system. Mr. Bauer stated that he did speak with Erich Dumbeck and Russ Leffler in regards to The Department of Job & Family Services.

Mike Adelman also stated that he did discuss the big ditch in Bellevue, and found that they were waiting for the weather to cooperate so that they can get in and do some cleaning of that ditch.

At 9:30 a.m. Carol Gibson, addressed the board in regards to the Gravelle case. Ms. Gibson stated that she did not feel that justice was served and that Job & Family Services/Children Services did not ask the question of "Why."

At 9:50 a.m. Tom Reese, Northern Ohio Rural Water, stated that they have hired 4 new employees bringing the number up to eighteen. Mr. Reese stated that the Board of Huron County Commissioners has put confidence back into this organization. Also stated that they have moved into four new townships.

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The board complimented Mr. Reese on his service to NORW.

At 10:00 a.m. Senator Sue Marano, and State Representative Matt Barrett came before the board to introduce themselves as newly elected officials. Representative Barrett spoke to a few issues such as: Contact information which stays the same. Stated that they have elected the Speaker of the House and everyone seems to be in agreement that they must work together. No bills introduced in regards to Local Government funds. And that is because there are no committees as of yet. Explained how the committees are formed. Stated that he is in favor of bringing back more control and more funding for the local govt. fund. Senator Sue Marano spoke in regards to their reorganization as well. Health Care and Education were her committee choices and explained why. Ms. Marano is also planning to send out a newsletter every other month.

Mike Adelman asked a question in terms of the Gravelle case in regards to what changes could be made at the state level. Representative Barrett stated that it has been quiet on the state level as far as the case is

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concerned and that he did not feel that Huron County has a black eye due to this case. Stated that this will be looked at across the state.

Ralph Fegley addressed the capital budget. Capital funding was awarded throughout the state; Huron County was not considered and did not receive any of the \$1.7 million. How these capital funds are spent is a concern to Mr. Fegley. Mr. Bauer explained to both Representative Barrett and Senator Marano that both of their predecessors worked hard on submitting the white paper to receive capital funds. Mr. Fegley also discussed the WIA and the job store. Discussed the possibility of moving that department under the Department of Development and taking away from DJFS. The concern is by making that change Huron County will loose the effectiveness that we have. We have a job store that other states have visited to learn how it works, as it works so well. Mr. Fegley once again stressed the importance of the Local Govt fund and it will cost the county \$900,000. Mr. Adelman stated not only maintain but to break the freeze. Mr. Bauer also spoke to the grade separations in the county and the changes to the ODOT.

At 10:42 a.m. the board recessed

At 10:55 a.m. regular session resumed.

Other Business cont.

Ralph Fegley reported on the Firefighters meeting and stated that their will be a Benefit dinner for Dennis Didion on January 27, 2007 from 11:00 a.m. -5:00 p.m. at the American Legion, Monroeville. Mr. Fegley stated that 26 contractors have picked up bid packets for the energy project, also stated the some discussion needs to be had in regards to moving records from the courthouse basement. Services for Aging would like to use a couple of rooms for their promotion team. Mr. Fegley also discussed the Natural Gas Consortium.

At 11:00 a.m. Erich Dumbeck and David Broehl came before the board. Mr. Bauer stated that he has been talking with the Prosecutor's Office. Mr. Dumbeck presented information and addressed the changes that have been made. The report from the DJFS and the review as to how this case looked dated Feb 2, 2006 which was given to him along with the corrective plan that has been put together. It was also discussed that Mr. Dumbeck became the director May 1, 2004 and that during the time of concern he was working in the Workforce Development area. Mr. Dumbeck also stated that he started as an investigator in 1997 and then moved to the Workforce Development side.

At 11:42a.m. the board recessed for five minutes.

At 11:46 a.m. regular session resumed. Mr. Adelman stated that we need to send a letter to the budget commission for two new cruisers for the sheriff. Cheryl Nolan to call sheriff and confirm the amount needed.

At 11:47 a.m. Gary W.
