Re: Main Street Norwalk Parking Issue

Date: March 8, 2007

It has been brought to the attention of the Board of Huron County Commissioners that county business use of the main street parking places near the Courthouse is reducing exposure to other businesses in the area. The Chamber of Commerce has previously stated that one parking space can result in \$20-30,000 in retail sales on a per-year basis. This is the busiest block in town.

On top of normal business, the Huron County Commissioners have just signed a contract for major mechanical and electrical work at the Courthouse and adjacent office buildings which will cause some further reduction in available parking in the area around these county facilities over the next six months. Contractor access will include a work trailer and lay down area for materials which will take away some of the parking behind the Courthouse, however, as we work with the engineering firm and contractors we will do everything we can to provide an efficient construction schedule which should keep parking as normal as possible.

The parking lot immediately east of the Courthouse is assigned parking only and has been for a number of years. Some of those assigned spaces are reserved for those who come and go daily from those buildings in county vehicles only.

We would appreciate your diligence in reducing main street parking of legal and business associates who come to Norwalk by working with them to use the available parking lots near the Courthouse complex rather than parking on Main Street. We thank you in advance for your positive support during this time when added congestion is going to occur in the area.

At 10:36 a.m. Gary W. Bauer moved to adjourn. Mike Adelman seconded the motion. The meeting stood adjourned.
