The Huron County Commissioners will accept your proposal of:

- 1. Reducing the overall balance due by \$20,000.00
- 2. Reducing the engineering costs on 22 East Main by \$3,000.00

However, we still must hold you to your commitment to resolve the performance issues with the heating and cooling systems that you designed and installed.

The boiler manufacturer believes that the balance problems with the heating system will never be resolved until a loop system is placed in the basement of the office building allowing each building to operate in a more independent manner of a loop from all boilers. We also were told that the computer system was set totally wrong and allows the boilers to cycle every 7-10 minutes, which is the worst thing we can do with these units. It is also the most expense from the gas use perspective. All these issues should have been engineered out in the beginning.

Last week, we agreed that you would provide a complete maintenance package to us including recommended spare parts, etc. We have not seen this package yet. As shown in the contract, you are to provide "As-Built" drawings of this project and since we are paying for the design of the new heating and cooling system for the office building we would expect that those drawings would be attached.

With one last thought we are still interested in obtaining outside funding for our court house foyer through grants or state capital funds.

We look forward to completing this project in a satisfactory manner.
