<u>At 10:00 a.m.</u> Tonia Maxwell, Dilger-Maxwell Insurance Agency, Inc. and David Campana, CGI Group Benefits came before the board to present a voluntary program through the Allstate Workplace Division. Mr. Campana explained how this program can be implemented and the benefits to the employee if implemented. Letters of recommendation were also presented. The board agreed to let RFPs in the near future for supplemental insurance.

At 10:30 a.m. Teresa Alt came before the board in regards to the community services block grant received from Erie Huron Community Action. Ms. Alt explained what this would entail, and explained that the awarded amount is \$34,570.00 which would allow them to open the site one day week but would try to put other funds with this so that they could open more for two day per week, but would see what the usage is going to be. The location is in Willard and Ms. Alt explained what they would be doing for the clients. They are planning an open house for October 2, 2009 and a flyer will be sent out in this regard.

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Cheryl Nolan presented the flu shots information for this year and stated that the vaccine will cost \$8.90 per dose. Last year 151 people received the vaccination. Ms. Nolan also explained that the cost of this will be paid from the insurance fund #560 which is the same fund that health insurance claims are paid. If the employees would go to the doctor to receive the vaccination it would cost \$20.00 rather that \$8.90 and is fully covered by insurance. The vaccine is less expensive this year as that year it cost \$2358.602 for 151 vaccinations. The board agreed to offer the flu vaccinations again this year and asked that some explanation be given as to what vaccination this is and how it is different from the H1N1 vaccination. The health department will prepare a flyer that will go out to the employees once they have a date set and will explain the difference between this flu vaccine and the H1N1 vaccination.

Mike Adelman moved to approve to offer the flu vaccination again this year with the health department providing this service. Larry J. Silcox seconded the motion. The roll being called upon its adoption, the vote resulted as follows:
