IN THE MATTER OF LEVYING REAL PROPERTY TRANSFER TAX PURSUANT TO SECTION 322.02 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

Mike Adelman moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 322.02 of the Ohio Revised Code and for the purpose of paying the costs of enforcing and administering this tax and providing additional general revenue for Huron County, it is the intent of the Board of Commissioners of Huron County to levy and collect a tax to be known as the real property transfer tax on each deed conveying real property located wholly or partially within the boundaries of Huron County at a rate of ten cents per one hundred dollars for each one hundred dollars of the value of the real property or interest in real property located within the boundaries of Huron County granted, assigned, transferred, or otherwise conveyed by such deed;

WHEREAS, the Board of Huron County Commissioners have conducted two public hearings thereon and have adhered to all requirements for enactment and passage of this resolution in conformance with Section 322.02 and all pertinent sections of the Ohio Revised Code;

now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- O5 Pursuant to Section 322.02 of the Ohio Revised Code and for the purpose of paying the costs of enforcing and administering this tax and providing additional general revenue for the county, the Board of County Commissioners of Huron County hereby enact and levy for collection a tax to be known as the real property transfer tax on each deed conveying real property or any interest in real property located wholly or partially within the boundaries of Huron County at a rate of ten cents per one hundred dollars for each one hundred dollars of the value of the real property or interest in real property located within the boundaries of Huron County granted, assigned, transferred or otherwise conveyed by such deed.
- This tax shall levied upon the grantor named in the deed and shall be paid by the grantor for the use of Huron County to the Huron County Auditor at the time of the delivery of the deed as provided in section 319.202 (319.20.2) of the Revised Code and prior to the presentation of the deed to the recorder of Huron County for recording.
- The ten cent increase will cause the permissive rate to go from \$0.20 per \$100 to \$0.30 per \$100 and the new rate is the maximum allowed by law.
- 4. The funds collected by a county levying a real property transfer tax or a manufactured home transfer tax pursuant to sections 322.01 to 322.07 of the Revised Code shall be allocated and disbursed as follows:

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- (A) First, for payment of the costs incurred by the county in the administration and enforcement of the tax.
- (B) At the discretion of the Board of Commissioners the balance may be used to promote development and tourism for Huron County.
- 5. This tax shall go into effect January 1, 2008.

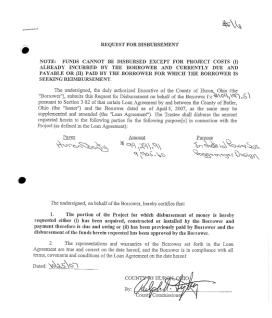
